

## ORDINANCE 21-32

### AN ORDINANCE REAPPORTIONING THE ALDERMANIC WARDS OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, TENNESSEE USING THE 2020 CENSUS BLOCK POPULATION DATA

**Whereas**, every ten years, following the latest decennial census, cities are required to reapportion their wards to get them as close to having equal numbers of population as possible, and;

**Whereas**, the 2020 Census has been taken and the block numbers have been distributed to all cities, and counties in the State of Tennessee by the Comptroller of the Treasury of the State of Tennessee, and the Census Bureau of the United States, and;

**Whereas**, the block numbers have been used to redraw the ward boundaries to get them into the required percentage of no more than ten percent (10%) difference between the highest population ward to the lowest, and;

**Whereas**, these ward boundaries have been reviewed by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Springfield.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Springfield, Tennessee as follows:

**Section 1.** The Proposed Ward Map, containing six (6) reapportioned wards with new boundaries, and being more fully described by "Exhibit A" attached is hereby adopted as the new Official Ward Map for Springfield, Tennessee.

**Section 2.** The ward map will become effective its third and final passage, as required by law.

Passed 1<sup>st</sup> reading: November 16, 2021

Passed 2<sup>nd</sup> reading: December 21, 2021

Passed 3<sup>rd</sup> reading: January 18, 2022

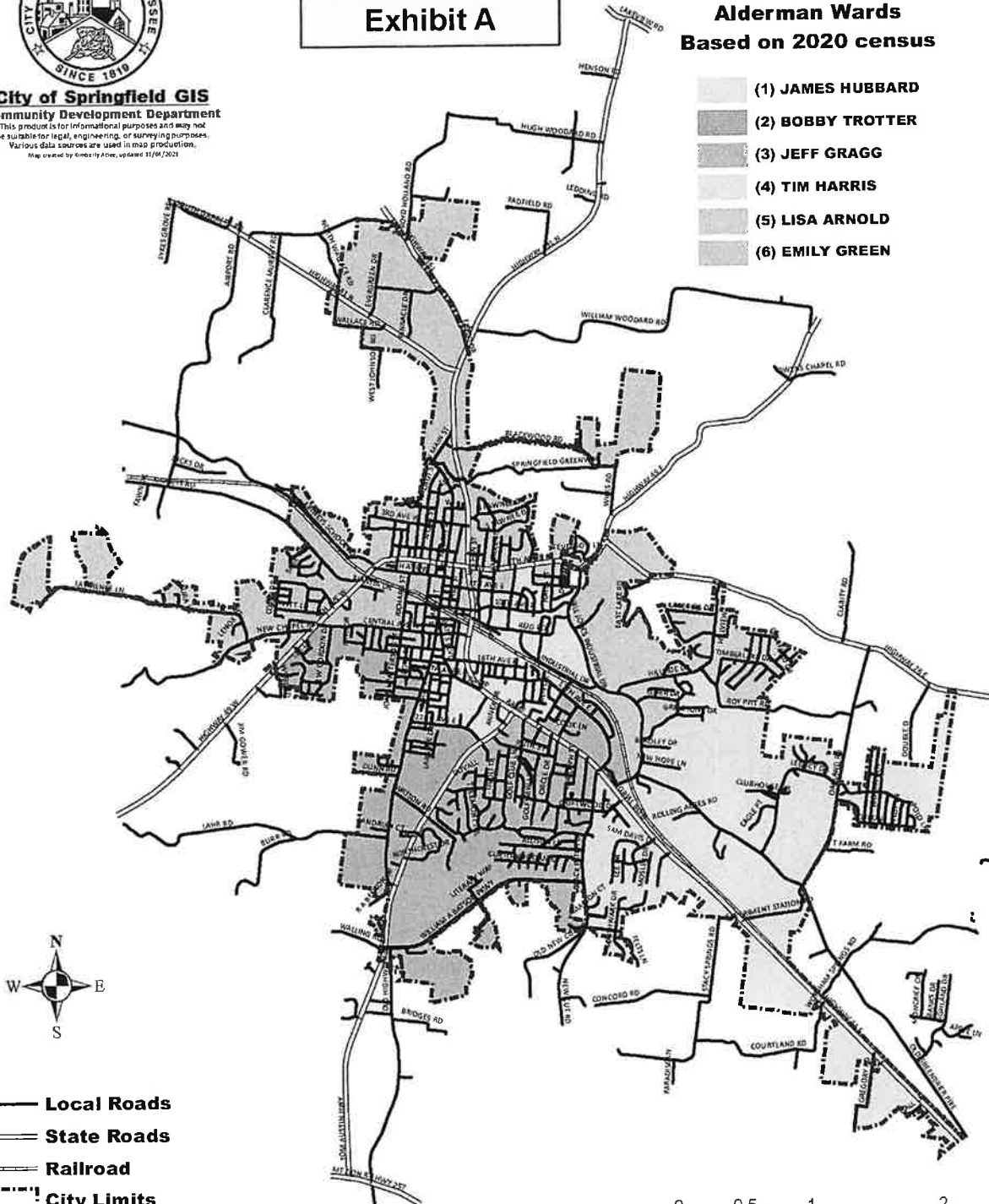
